Evaluation/Training Period

At this point you will be considered a contracted employee and paid minimum wage. We will be checking in with you regularly to see how the work is going and address any concerns. At the end of your training we hold an evaluation meeting to talk about your experience and address any additional concerns. This meeting goes both ways, we may have issues to discuss as well. Milwaukie Floral and Garden is a tight-knit team and working together in a cohesive manner is extremely important. If, at any time, you feel you must terminate your position, we ask that you give two weeks notice.
